The second Sunday of each month is our Open Stage night, hosted by Scott Engstrom. Come and enjoy our great local talent! Listeners encouraged and you will be pleasantly surprised at the diverse musical styles presented. Anyone who would like to perform is encouraged to do so. Regardless of who's on stage, you'll never find a more supportive audience. Music starts at 7 pm, but come a little earlier to sign up. Each performer is allowed up to 2 songs covering about 10 minutes. At evening's end, time permitting may allow for an additional song.

Thirty years as a professional songwriter and traveling troubadour serve as credentials. As a solo performer, and as the trusted sidekick of Texas Americana songwriting icon Guy Clark, Verlon has viewed the world from stages everywhere from Barcelona to Binger, his hometown in Oklahoma.

Along the way Verlon Thompson compositions have been recorded by Jimmy Buffett and Alan Jackson, Anne Murray, The Nitty Gritty Dirt Band, Kenny Rogers, Randy Travis, Del McCoury, Sam Bush, Trisha Yearwood and many more.

Equally important in his songwriting and live performances, Verlon's guitar work cannot go unnoticed. His guitar can be heard on recordings by **Restless Heart**, **Pam Tillis**, and many more, including, and especially Guy Clark.

Verlon Thompson is currently on the road, or in the studio, or writing in his bunkhouse on the river in Tennessee, but never far from the fertile plains of Oklahoma.

Consummate musicians and storytellers, Kim & Reggie Harris are a mini festival of diversity. Combining traditional African-American spirituals and freedom songs with original folk, they sing of life, love, the quest for freedom, environment and community. Their latest CD, "Resurrection Day," binds these themes into a profoundly moving personal odyssey of inspiration and hope, adding Reggie's experience as an organ donor recipient to the social justice palette. Written in the aftermath of his liver transplant due to an autoimmune disease, Reggie found his songs had "deepened in theme, subject matter, and in musical tone.

For over two decades, Kim & Reggie have been affiliated with the John F Kennedy Center's Partners in Education program, offering multimedia educational performances for students and community, "Music & The Underground Railroad" and "Dream Alive."

Kim & Reggie Harris combine a strong folk and gospel legacy with a solid background in classical, rock, jazz and pop music. As socially conscious acoustic musicians and storytellers, they have been "walking the talk" for over 30 years, performing modern and historical songs that explore societal ills and proffer positive social messages. Their captivating stage presence and unique harmonies have earned them the respect and love of audiences throughout the US, Canada, and Europe. They are unique in their ability to entertain audiences of any age and background as they blend their talents as singers, songwriters, educators, interpreters of history and cultural advocates
