Everybody gets a chance to play or sing songs of their own choosing ... or to play and sing along with others. The circle keeps going 'round to everybody until it's time to call it a night. Jenny and Robin LIVE at Folkstage' was recorded as part of 98.7 WFMT's Folkstage radio program in 2014. Up to that date, Jenny was known as a solo artist, and Robin for his work with the band Twang Bang.

Jenny's music has been described as falling "somewhere between winking innocence and worldly detachment," and Robin's wild guitar stylings harken back to the earliest forms of Jazz, Blues and Country guitar. Both write songs that are quirky snapshots and celebrations of modern life in all of its wonderful, strange and hilarious beauty.
