

Lee Murdock (Holiday Special)



There is an amazing timelessness in Lee Murdock's music. His musical influences span 15 generations, and combine original compositions with traditional music. Noted as a fluent instrumentalist on six and 12-string guitars, Lee combines ragtime, Irish, blues and folk styles with a flair for storytelling in his repertoire firmly grounded in work-song tradition from the rugged days of lumberjacks and wooden sailing schooners (with a bend on the Great Lakes).

Open Stage / Second Sundays

The second Sunday of each month is our Open Stage night, hosted by Scott Engstrom. Come out and enjoy some great local musical talent! Non-performing listeners are always encouraged and will be pleasantly surprised with the diverse musical styles represented. There's a little something for everyone.

Anyone who would like to perform is encouraged to do so.

You'll never find a more supportive audience than at the LCFC. Music starts at 7 PM, but come a little earlier to sign up. Each performer is allowed up to two songs spanning about 10 minutes. If time permits (and it usually does) artists can perform an additional song near evening's end.

On the fourth Sunday of each month we hold our Song Circle. Members and non-members are welcome...players and listeners alike are encouraged.
